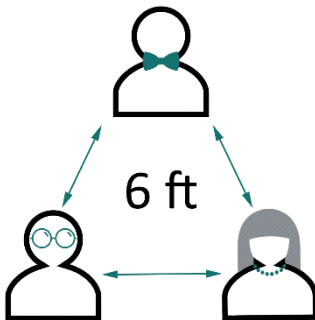
### PASSENGER FLOW

- Strategic distancing and directional signage to improve passenger flow
- Reduce passenger touch points by keeping access doors open during boarding



### SEATING MODIFICATIONS

- Update design configuration of indoor/outdoor seating to maximize passenger count
- Update stability calculations for additional overhangs and rearrangement of passengers
- Increase shelter for outdoor seating
- Add loading/offloading points



### PASSENGER SPACE MODIFICATIONS

- Redesign of cafeteria and bathrooms
- Motion sensor utilities
- Additional space for waiting areas or cleaning storage
- Increase sanitation stations
- Add sneeze guards
- Automation of passenger touch points
- HVAC improvements
- Update fire, safety or escape plans
